Treasurer's report 2023-2024

I am pleased to report that the ATC has made a profit of \$ 1,724.55 this last financial year (1/10/23 to 30/9/24) despite receiving no sails royalties this year.

Income

State levy: Set at \$15 per boat the levy is the main regular income for the ATC. The levy for the year is \$1875.00 boosted by record attendance at the Nationals and Worlds

Nationals levy: The same applies for the Nationals levy doubled this year to \$1320.00

Qld association: As the QLD association has not re-formed as planned, QLD membership are included in other states

Website

WTC is now paying website expenses directly (one last reimbursement done this year) . Donations on the website have generated \$215

Expenses

Affiliation and insurance: these are our main recurring expenses, and both Affiliation to AS and insurance have slightly increased.

Other expenses: individual trophies bought for the Nationals.

Conclusion:

The ATC is now back in a sound financial position. And I propose that levies be maintained at current level State levy \$ 15 per boat – Nationals levy \$ 20 per boat

We need considering replacing Treasurer/President as I have been holding both positions since I took over from Nicole earlier this year.
